

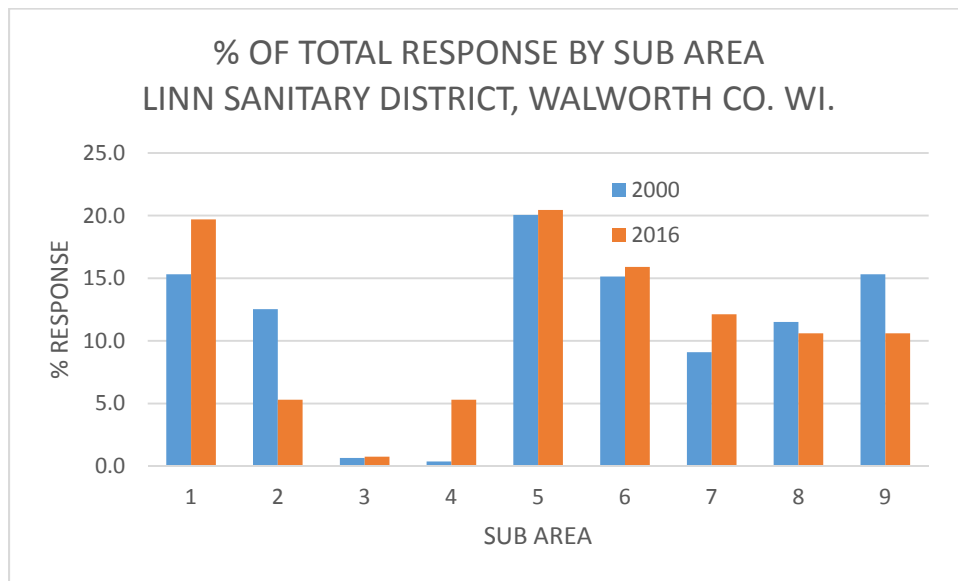
Results - Linn Sanitary District's On-Line Survey of the District's Residents Regarding Their Preferred Future Sanitary Waste Management - Summer of 2016

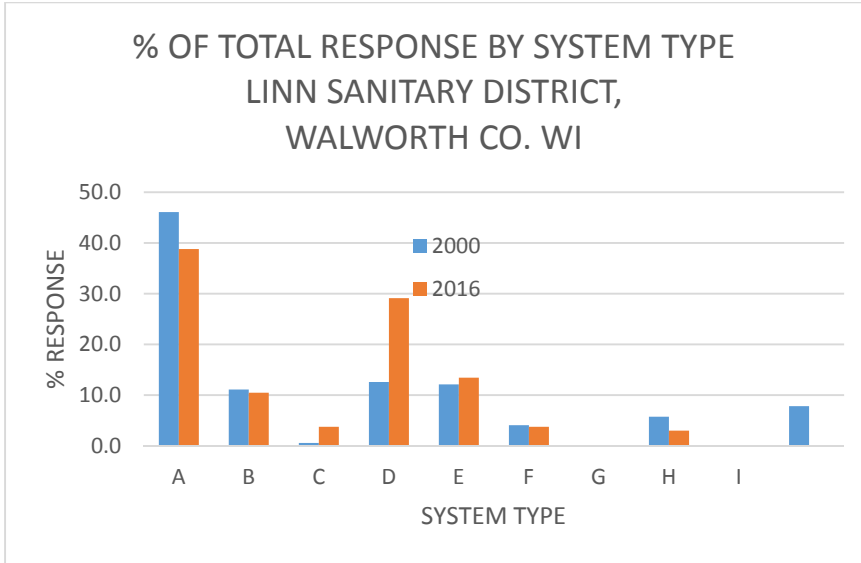
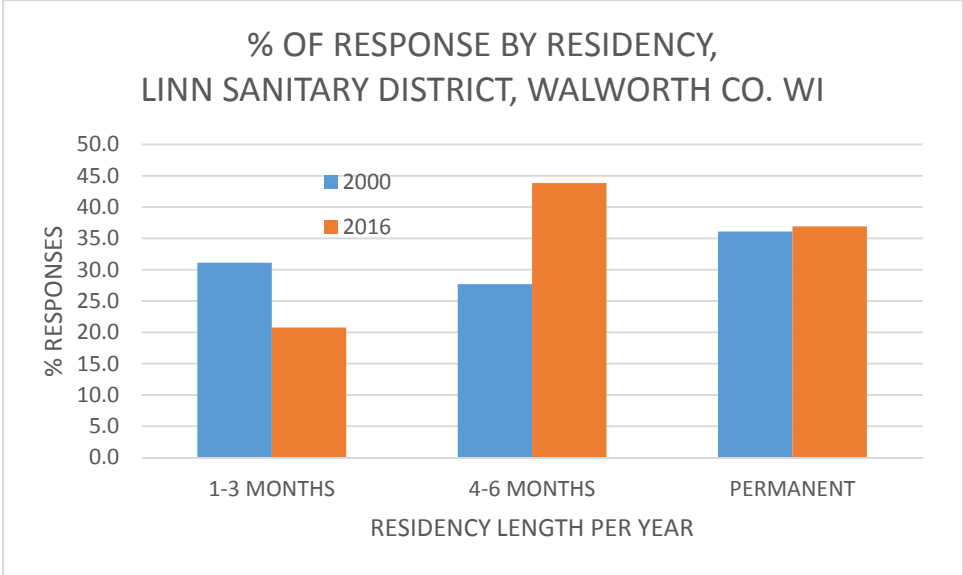

In the early 2000's the Linn Sanitary District conducted an extensive mail-out survey of its residents to inventory the preferred choice for future sanitary waste management within the District. At that time, it was estimated that there were 1,846 improved parcels in the Linn Sanitary District. Based upon responses from 1,083 District residents, the preferred choice of sanitary waste management was for on-site wastewater treatment (78%). Thus, the District began a wastewater management program that included private on-site wastewater treatment system inspections and well testing.

During the summer of 2016 the Linn Sanitary District conducted an on-line survey to see if that preference had changed over the last 15 years. Using an on-line survey the District re-asked the same questions that were asked in the 2000 survey. With about 135 responses the preference was again for the on-site wastewater treatment option (61%). Graphic assessment of the results along with a comparison of the 2016 and the 2000 responses follows.

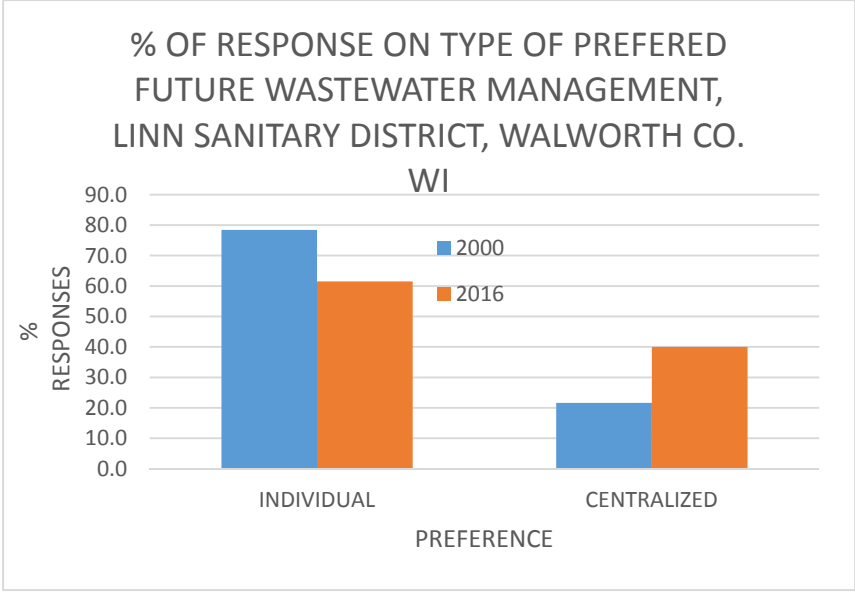
Followed by the 2000 – 2016 response comparison below.
