RESOLUTION TO EXTEND STATE OF EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on March 18, 2020, the Town Board declared an emergency within the Town of Linn, Walworth County, Wisconsin, due to the threat of a disaster based upon the existence of COVID-19 in the State, that impairs transportation, food and fuel supplies, medical care, fire, health or police protection, or other critical systems of the local units of government per s. 323.11, Wis. Stats.; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board adopted resolution 2020-008 to close Town facilities to the public until April 6, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on March 23, 2020, Governor Evers issued Emergency Order #12, "Safer At Home Order", prohibiting all non-essential travel from March 25, 2020 until April 24, 2020; and

WHEREAS, as of March 25, 2020, Walworth County, Wisconsin, has five laboratory confirmed cases of COVID-19; and


WHEREAS, the Town Board finds extraordinary proactive measures are necessary to prevent death and injury of persons and to protect the public peace, safety and welfare, and alleviate damage, loss, hardship or suffering; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to prevent the spread of COVID-19, Town facilities will remain closed until April 24, 2020, with the exception of poll sites on April 7, 2020, unless the Spring Election and Presidential Preference Primary is postponed by the Wisconsin Elections Commission; and


FURTHER, the period of emergency and Town facility closures shall be limited to the time during which the emergency conditions exist or are likely to exist in the Town of Linn as determined by the Town Chairman.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED this resolution shall become effective upon adopting by the Town Board of the Town of Linn, Walworth County, Wisconsin.
