

PROJECT: Shadow Lane Walking Bridge Replacement

LOCATION OF PROJECT: North (Dead End) of Shadow Ln., which is in the Town of Linn, County of Walworth. GPS 42.55058 -88.527855

DESCRIPTION: The Town of Linn is soliciting bids to fully remove and replace the existing walking bridge on the walking path of Geneva Lake. The bridge extends over a natural waterway that flows parallel to Shadow Ln. from the southern area of Shadow Ln. at the intersection of South Lake Shore Dr. and into the Geneva Lake body of water.

The bridge is located approximately 38 ft. north of the end of the paved portion of Shadow Ln., and 22 ft. south of the water's edge of the lakeshore itself. New bridge is to be constructed of steel framing instead of wood, and decking be fiberglass planks. Minimal changes to the bridge include extending the length of the bridge from its current 22 ft. length to 26 ft., raising the bottom of the bridge to a minimum height of 36 inches above the top of the water line, a width of 36 inches, and 3 ft. on/off ramps at either entrance to the bridge.

Pricing must separate costs of bridge removal, construction, and installation.

Pricing must be valid until September 30, 2021.
